

LUNCH

*** The Texas Department of Agriculture prohibits parents/family members from bringing food items to other children at school. Please provide lunches to your child/children only. ***

Meal charges must be prepaid. Statements will be mailed monthly showing account balances. If a student's balance reaches \$0, the account must be brought current and a prepayment made within 20 days. If the lunch bill is not paid within 20 days, the student will have to bring a lunch from home until charges are paid in full, plus a prepayment made. Wellman-Union ISD participates in the National School Lunch Program and offers free and reduced price lunches based on a student's financial need. Information can be obtained from the business office. We encourage everyone to apply.

*Any unpaid balances related to school activities whether lunch bills, cheerleading, lost books and/or fines will result in the student not being allowed to participate in extracurricular activities until the accounts have been brought current.

If a student has an unpaid balance at the end of the school year, that balance must be made current immediately or the student's transfer will be denied.

It is the purpose of the cafeteria to serve a wholesome, balanced lunch and breakfast. The cafeteria is operated as cheaply as possible with NO INTENTION OF MAKING A PROFIT. Its services are open to all students who desire to eat at school. All food must be eaten in the cafeteria.
