

Site Based Committee Meeting
November 25, 2008
Minutes

Meeting was called to order by Russell Schaub at 7:17 a.m.

Russell Schaub explained the purpose of the meeting was to review the Federal/State Programs and Student needs in the district as well as policies/other information that support these programs. A Comprehensive Needs Assessment for the DIP was reviewed for each program. A motion was made by Shauna Youngblood and seconded by Todd Ellis to approve the DIP and Comprehensive Needs Assessment and to present it to the School Board. Motion Passed 10-0.

The Committee reviewed the tentative entitlements and the intent and purposes for each Federal Program. This information was included in the DIP. Program and expenditure discussions were held for each applicable program.

Student and State program needs were reviewed for the Committee. The intents of these programs as well as who was responsible for compliance was reviewed. See Fall District Site Base Meeting Agenda for list of programs discussed.

07 - 08 Parent Involvement Activities were reviewed. Input was taken for future activities/educational topics/scheduling of parent meetings. The Committee also reviewed how parents are informed of their NCLB right to: be involved in their child's education; request qualifications of student's classroom teachers; 4 Weeks Notice of student being taught by Non-Highly Qualified Teachers; parent teacher conferences – all elementary/any secondary student not passing TAKS; annual School-Parent-Student Compact; information on the level of achievement for required assessments of their children.

The Committee discussed possible needs for the 2009-2010 school year and made recommendations. The final Staff Development calendar/activities will be finalized at a future SBDM meeting.

The Homeless Policy and Safe Schools (FDD-local) Policy were reviewed. The Parent Involvement Policies for the District and each campus were reviewed and accepted by the committee. Each campus School-Parent Compact was reviewed and accepted for the next year.

The committee reviewed information pertaining to Accountability, AYP, PBMAS, and Comparability.
