THE DUANE MOSS CONSERVATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Terry Soil and Water Conservation District offers the Duane Moss Conservation Scholarship to graduating seniors in Terry County who are interested in majoring in an ag-related degree and/or pursuing an ag-related career. This scholarship is not confined to only those involved in agriculture, but preference shall be given to those applicants meeting all requirements who are choosing agriculture related fields as their career path. The funds are to reimburse the college for the student's tuition, fees and/or books in the amount not to exceed the total specified sum. Any unexpended balance of the scholarship may be used to defray other legitimate expenses incidental to college attendance.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The 2021 Duane Moss Conservation Scholarship will be in the amount of \$2,000 to be paid in increments of \$250.00 per semester for a total of 8 semesters.

ELIGIBILITY

Any current year graduating senior of a Terry County high school is eligible to apply for the Scholarship. The recipient must begin college the fall semester immediately following selection. The scholarship funds will be sent directly to the Financial Aid office of the recipients chosen college or university at the rate specified above as long as these requirements are met and maintained:

- (1) A GPA of 2.5 or above is maintained.
- (2) The recipient remains enrolled for 8 consecutive semesters.
- (3) Recipient will provide to the District the following items after previous semester and prior to upcoming semester. Items must be provided to the District before scholarship payment will be paid. Failure to provide the District with the following items will result in loss of scholarship.
 - Verification of enrollment for upcoming semester.
 - GPA for previous semester.
 - If any scholarship recipient graduates early, and continues on to graduate school the remaining scholarship funds will be carried over to graduate school.

SELECTION

Each applicant should submit a typewritten summary of achievements and explain their scholastic and career goals. This statement should not exceed 2 pages. **High school transcripts signed by the principal or superintendent must also accompany the application.** Incomplete applications will not be accepted. The Terry SWCD Board of Directors will serve as the selection committee. Selection will be made based on a combination of need, scholastic performance and record of accomplishment.
