## THE DUANE MOSS CONSERVATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Terry Soil and Water Conservation District offers the Duane Moss Conservation Scholarship to graduating seniors in Terry County who are interested in majoring in an ag-related degree and/or pursuing an ag-related career. This scholarship is not confined to only those involved in agriculture, but preference shall be given to those applicants meeting all requirements who are choosing agriculture related fields as their career path. The funds will be paid to the recipient.

### AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The 2026 Duane Moss Conservation Scholarship will be in the amount of \$1,000.00

### ELIGIBILITY

Any current year graduating senior of a Terry County high school is eligible to apply for the Scholarship. The recipient must begin college or Trade School the fall semester immediately following selection.

1. Verification of enrollment for upcoming semester.
2. High School transcript

### SELECTION

Each applicant should submit a typewritten summary of achievements and explain their scholastic and career goals. This statement should not exceed 2 pages. **High school transcripts signed by the principal or superintendent must also accompany the application.** Incomplete applications will not be accepted. The Terry SWCD Board of Directors will serve as the selection committee. Selection will be made based on a combination of need, scholastic performance and record of accomplishment.
