Proposals will be received by email or by mail in the Wellman-Union CISD District Administration Office at 5th & Terry. (P.O. Box 69); Wellman, TX 79378 **until 10 am Monday, December 16th**, at the proposal opening. In accordance with CH (LOCAL):

- Proposals received after the specified time shall not be considered.
- Proposals shall be opened at the time specified.
- Proposals may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled time of opening.
- Changes in the content of a proposal, and in prices, may be negotiated after proposals are opened.

The district reserves the right to reject any and all proposals or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any proposals or in the proposal process, and to be the sole judge of the merit and qualifications of products or services offered. Furthermore, the District may accept whichever proposal is deemed to be in the best interest of the district.

Purpose/Requirements:

The purpose is to obtain proposal for video surveillance district wide. WU seeks qualified proposers to provide video surveillance equipment, including hardware and software that supports the District's current and long-term surveillance needs.

Onsite Visit: Prior to submitting a proposal, potential proposers must set a time with Roger Chase (IT Director) rchase@esc17.net for an onsite visit to clarify the scope, specifications, any other requirements, or answer questions for the project.

Minimum Proposal Specifications:

Proposals shall include:

- Terms: 5-year contract option, to include a total cost, installation, and breakdown of all cost.
 - Web based monitoring system, payable up front, in full (grant funded).
- Specifications:
 - 60+ Cameras, 5+ Monitoring devices (all hardware included) that meet or exceed the specs of the District's current system.
 - Hardware and Software preferred compatibility with WU current systems to include but not limited to, Avigilon Door System.
 - Warranty: 5 years minimum on all items/work.
- A statement of how the company intends to work with the District to ensure timely maintenance and upkeep occur, to ensure minimal downtime of system.
- Reference list of other districts or similar entities the proposer provides similar services.
- Physical address of main office of the company.
- An overall cost and breakdown of all costs associated with the agreement.
